Course Overview

This is an engineering-level competence-based course for designers of equipment / systems needing to meet ATEX requirements. EN (or IEC) 60079-14 standards require persons who design equipment or systems for use in potentially explosive atmospheres to be properly trained and certified as “competent” - this course is designed to fulfill that requirement. Anyone who has the responsibility for ensuring that such equipment or systems is suitable and in compliance with the ATEX directive and / or EN (or IEC) standards will benefit from this course.
